Emakoko

Nairobi, Kenya

THE EMAKOKO is a family-owned and run lodge artfully built into the side of a valley on the Mbagathi River, which borders the Nairobi National Park a mere 20 minute transfer from both airports in Nairobi city. The Emakoko allows people to start and finish their safari in the wildlife environment they have travelled so far to enjoy.



If stress is what you are escaping from, and rest is what you need, then The Emakoko is the perfect place...



ACCOMMODATION. The beautifully appointed rooms look out over the game park so one can fall asleep to the sounds of Africa, a lion roaring or the cry of a lone hyena, an amazing contrast to the sounds of traffic, ambulances, fire engines and dogs barking which are the normal sounds of any sleeping city. There are five rooms on the same level as the main areas and a further five rooms with the most spectacular views positioned on top of the cliff, overlooking the valley.



ACTIVITIES. Take a game drive into one of the most unique game parks in the world, Nairobi National Park or visit the community that border it. Otherwise an excursion into Nairobi to visit the David Sheldrick wildlife trust, the giraffe centre or the local shops may be more appealing. Finally for the more adventurous, a helicopter trip to the world famous Masai Mara, or up Mt. Kenya might be the better alternative.

Lewa House



LEWA WILDLIFE CONSERVANCY, KENYA



Endangered species - rhino, Grevy's Zebra, sitatunga - abound in the Lewa Wildlife Conservancy where guests can experience as great a wildlife viewing as anywhere in Africa.



LOCATED IN THE BEAUTIFUL COUNTRYSIDE at the foot of Mt. Kenya, the Lewa Downs is one of Kenya's major private conservation success stories. It has been in the Craig family home since 1924 when the Craig's grandparents came from England and began raising cattle here. This area is committed to the conservation of wildlife and diverse habitats found on the northern slopes of Mt Kenya.



Lewa Downs is one of very few private ranches in the world where you can see such a remarkable variety of wildlife and their interaction with each other in a natural habitat.



THE PROPERTY has a main building with a lounge and dining area, opening up to the charmingly furnished stretch veranda with its own special vista across the plains of Northern Kenya. A short walk away there are three large cottages each with a double and a twin room, making the property suitable for up to twelve people. A large swimming pool overlooking the waterhole is also yours to enjoy at Lewa House.

Ol Malo

North Eastern Province, Kenya



OL MALO, meaning “the place of the Greater Kudu,” is Colin and Rocky Francombe’s home. The 5,000-acre ranch and game sanctuary lies along the Uaso Nyiro River along the edge of Kenya’s North East Province. It overlooks the Mukogodo, home of the nomadic Ndorobo people, with views that unveil the very face of



Colin & Rocky Francombe are both children of Kenya. Colin’s father arrived in Kenya in 1927 and as an early East African aviator, he became renowned as one of the best bush pilots in the country. Colin developed the property into a prime cattle and sheep ranch, as well as a wonderful sanctuary for wild animals including the endangered black rhino. Rocky & Colin are amazing hosts living in a pristine part of Africa where they share their unusual lives, stories and experiences with a few fortunate guests.

Days at Ol Malo are as full or unruffled as guests prefer. Picnics and sun downers in the bush; day and night game drives in rugged land cruisers; escorted walks for bird and game viewing; interesting treks with camels and visits to a colorful Samburu Manyatta.



Built of natural rock with thatched roofs, Ol Malo is shaped by the rocks and the curve of ancient olive wood. The separate living area and dining room, each with an open fireplace for the cool evenings, have large windows overlooking a magnificent valley. There are four double guest houses discreetly nestled between rocks on cliffs overlooking a much-frequented water hole and salt lick, surrounded by miles of rugged wilderness.





SARUNI MARA

Masai Mara, Kenya

SARUNI is an eco-friendly and community-friendly deluxe safari lodge in the Masai Mara, the most exciting wildlife sanctuary in Africa. Located inside the Masai-owned Mara North Conservancy, Saruni Mara offers the thrill of a real African adventure coupled with the highest standards of style and comfort. With accommodation for only 12 guests in six cottages, Saruni is set in a remote valley of forests and hills, overlooking open savannas.



Discover the beauty and skills of the Maasai people. Based on a close partnership with the local community and built to ecological standards, Saruni entwines old traditions of classic safaris and modern technology.



ACCOMMODATION. Your safari actually starts on massive cedar beds, from where you can see in total privacy elephant, leopard, waterbuck, bushbuck and impala traversing freely and peacefully in the grounds of the camp. Kuro House is the common dining area and is a mixture of old-fashioned Africa and modern design, its huge fireplace is the focal point of life at Saruni and it is here that our guests exchange memories of the day's safaris. While reminiscing they can start to savour the cuisine that is served around our long table and uses fresh, locally grown organic produce in inventive ways. Alternatively meals can be taken in the bush among the wild animals...

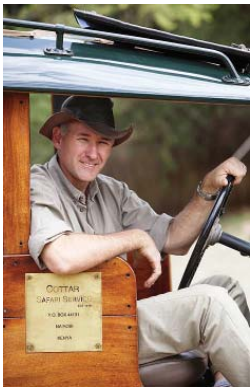


ACTIVITIES. Drive or walk among elephants, giraffes, lions, zebras and endless other species of wild animals, accompanied in total safety by our professional guides in the magic of old Africa. For safaris, Saruni uses open Land-Rovers, specially designed to give maximum visibility over the landscape and the animals. On foot safaris we walk on the plains and in the mountains and hills, that surround Saruni.

Cottars 1920's Camp



THE COTTARS SAFARI TRADITION BEGAN IN 1919 and for more than 80 years they have provided an unparalleled safari experience to discerning clients. Cottars Safari Service is legendary for its level of luxury and attention to detail, re-creating the golden age of “safari” – an era of romance, professional guiding, adventure, and elegance.



This legendary camp is ensconced in 250,000 acres held by a community of 3,000 Maasai in the remote area of the Olentoroto Hills, just outside the boundary of the Mara Game Reserve. This area is pristine, untouched by any kind of tourism or development and offers exquisite privacy. You will feel as if you have been transported back in time, especially when you are served afternoon tea from silver poured into china by a waiter kitted out in a crimson fez and vest over a full length Swahili tunic. Come nightfall, candles and lanterns are lit and the Cottars' magic continues.



THE CONCESSION is situated in the only part of the Masai Mara where your privacy can be ensured and where you will never see tourists and mini-buses. Since the camp is located outside the game parks, our trained trackers will take you on guided walks where you will be close to nature and experience wild game tracking safely and beautifully. There will also be opportunities for exciting night drives in the conservancy. And we have a full-time masseuse at camp, so if you feel like a bit of pampering – enjoy massages, manicures or pedicures.

The Cottars 1920's Safari Camp accommodates up to twelve travelers in authentic white canvas tents. Each is spacious and luxuriously furnished with original circa 1920's safari antiques, a private en-suite dressing room and bathroom (with shower and flushing toilet), a main bedroom, and an outdoor veranda.



OL DONYO LODGE



Chyulu Hills, Kenya

IMAGINE... 275,000 acres of scenic Africa, where the wildlife can be found free and roaming. Imagine travelling across the archetypal savannahs of East Africa in an open 4x4 game drive vehicle without limitation, feeling the rhythm of Africa beneath your feet as you walk with expert trackers, or horseback ride with Mt. Kilimanjaro as a backdrop.



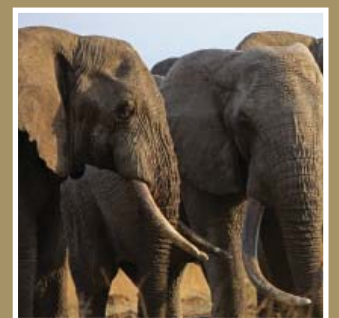
OL DONYO LODGE consists of ten expansive guest suites in six stand-alone villas. No two spaces are of the same design but all have a dramatic view of the archetypal African savannah and its flat top acacia trees with Mount Kilimanjaro in the background.



STRONG POPULATIONS of wildlife find their habitat in and around the ol Donyo Lodge environs. Track game on a walking safari on the Mbirikani Group Ranch which features an incredible diversity of habitats. Perhaps the most unique is the high-altitude mist forest, where leopard and rhino lurk, and an incredible amount of biodiversity is present. The Chyulu Hills and its diverse ecosystem also lend itself perfectly to horseback safaris. Or, view wildlife on mountain bike, which is an exhilarating exploratory activity. Set out across the savannahs with an armed guide and enjoy the freedom of riding on the open plains.



THE REAL EXCLUSIVITY of ol Donyo is apparent when out exploring the land. The entire area is reserved exclusively for ol Donyo guests – no other tourists, no fleets of mini-buses – it's private, pure and wild. Each day is different, there is no set routine. While it may be tempting to laze around the lovely suites, and bask in the sun next to the private pool, the diverse activities at ol Donyo Lodge are equally as alluring.

Best time to travel to Kenya is from June to October and again from December to March. The rainy season months are November, April and May.

PEOPLE

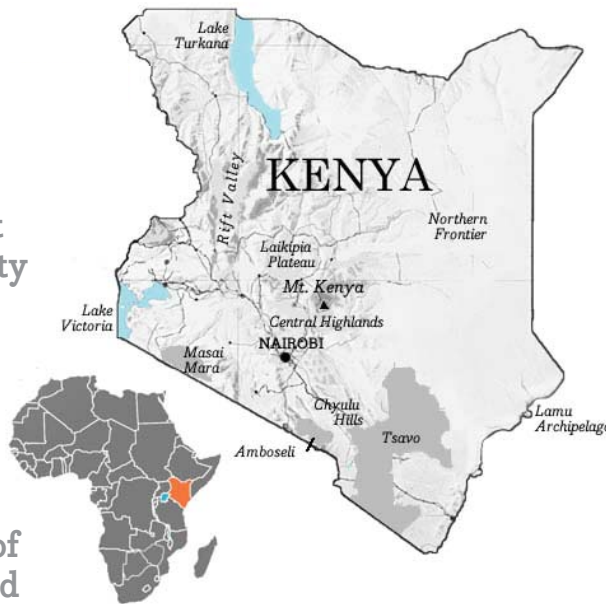
There are more than 40 tribes in Kenya, the most distinct being the Masai and Samburu. These tribes are still found in rural areas, dressed in their traditional style, living a relatively nomadic life, tending herds of cattle. It is interesting to note that these people have been integrated into a developing industrial nation without having to relinquish tribal customs and values.

WEATHER

Because Kenya is located on the equator, there are no extremes in the seasonal temperatures and there is little humidity. The elevation of Nairobi is 5,500 feet with the most of your safari conducted at elevations of 4,500 feet or higher. The nights are cool, averaging 50 to 60°F, with highs ranging from 70 to 90°F. The rainy season is from April to May, with some short rains in November. The coolest months are July-August, and the warmest months are late December to mid-March. The coast is warm and often humid, with a steady breeze.

KENYA

The great safari land of Kenya is without doubt the stuff of legend, not just for their mighty tribes and proud warriors, or the intrepid explorers and fearless pioneers of days gone by, but also the magnificence of their landscape and wildlife.



Kenya is located on the East Coast of Africa, astride the equator. It is truly a land of contrasts; comprising arid desert, rich savanna land, mountains, large lakes and dense forests. The coastal area along the shores of the Indian Ocean has tranquil beaches, turquoise waters and a wealth of history.

RATES

Please note that prices are based on 2012/2013 and current exchange rates. Rates are subject to change due to currency fluctuations and will be re-confirmed at time of full payment. Please note that the charter & scheduled flights are based on current rates and routings, and are subject to change. We reserve the right to alter any published rates by giving notice in writing.

PLEASE NOTE FOR DOMESTIC AIRLINES

All private charter flights are subject to weight limits that cannot be exceeded for safety reasons. If these weight limits are exceeded then the travelers will be held responsible for the extra costs incurred to upgrade the charter flight. Sometimes these flights cannot be upgraded due to the availability of larger aircraft - this could result in a delay in travel time and present problems for travelers. Passengers are limited to soft bags and with a maximum total weight of 33 lbs (this includes hand baggage). Limitations are strictly adhered to on all flights within Kenya & Tanzania. In the event of bad weather prevailing, it may be necessary to upgrade to a twin-engine plane, which is approved for instrument flight conditions. If this occurs, the extra cost of the twin-engine plane will be your responsibility. The Company has no control and accepts no liability whatsoever for cancellations or delays which are subject to operational decisions by the carriers. All flights are subcontracted to independent aviation Companies who are entirely responsible, and therefore liable, for all aspects of the flying operation.

REASONS FOR PURCHASING TRAVEL INSURANCE

The terrorism attacks on September 11th, 2001, signaled a redefining moment for U.S. travelers. In response to the unprecedented logistical and psychological impact of these and recent events, travel insurers have revised their policies concerning travel.

Unlike most elements of vacation planning, travel insurance isn't alluring, exciting, or even remotely interesting, which might be why so many travelers don't even consider it when planning their trips. When it comes to protecting your vacation investment and, sometimes, even your well-being, nothing is more important than travel insurance. Traveling to Africa is expensive and it is an "investment" that should be protected for the following reasons:

- To protect your family
- To protect your health and belongings.
- To have assistance anytime and anywhere.
- To achieve greater peace of mind.

TRIP CANCELLATION: Perhaps the most important coverage of all, trip-cancellation insurance will reimburse the cost of your trip if you're forced to cancel your plans for any of a number of covered reasons. These include your falling ill, death or illness of a family member.

Trip Interruption: By purchasing trip interruption insurance, you will be protected from unexpected events that results in delays or premature end to your vacation.

MEDICAL INSURANCE: Having comprehensive medical coverage at home does not mean you will always be protected abroad. Travel-insurance packages typically come with medical coverage and include the cost of air evacuation when deemed necessary by the insurer. The medical coverage of travel insurance policies is supplemental, meaning it reimburses you for whatever amount your primary health insurance doesn't cover. An excellent supplement to travel medical insurance is the services offered by Medjet Assist, an air-ambulance company that flies members to whatever medical facility they choose if they are hospitalized on a trip abroad and require further hospitalization.

WAR & TERRORIST THREAT: War or the "threat" of a terrorist act is not covered, for example: 1) If you decide to cancel your plans because of a "threat" at your specific destination, you will not be covered. 2) if a terrorist incident/violence occurs within 30 days of your scheduled arrival, then you are covered.

WEATHER: You are protected if you are forced to cancel due to inclement weather that causes an airline to cease operations. Note: In order to recover any money from a vacation canceled for weather-related reasons, the insurance policy must have been purchased before the storm appeared on the weather map.

UNCHARTED OUTPOSTS CANCELLATION POLICY

Deposits are non-refundable. Balance of payment is due 60 days prior to departure. Cancellations received are subject to the following forfeiture of trip cost: 61+ days prior to departure - full forfeiture of deposit. 30-60 days - 50% of total trip cost is forfeited. 0-30 days - 100% total trip cost is forfeited. We STRONGLY urge and recommend the purchase of trip cancellation/insurance.
